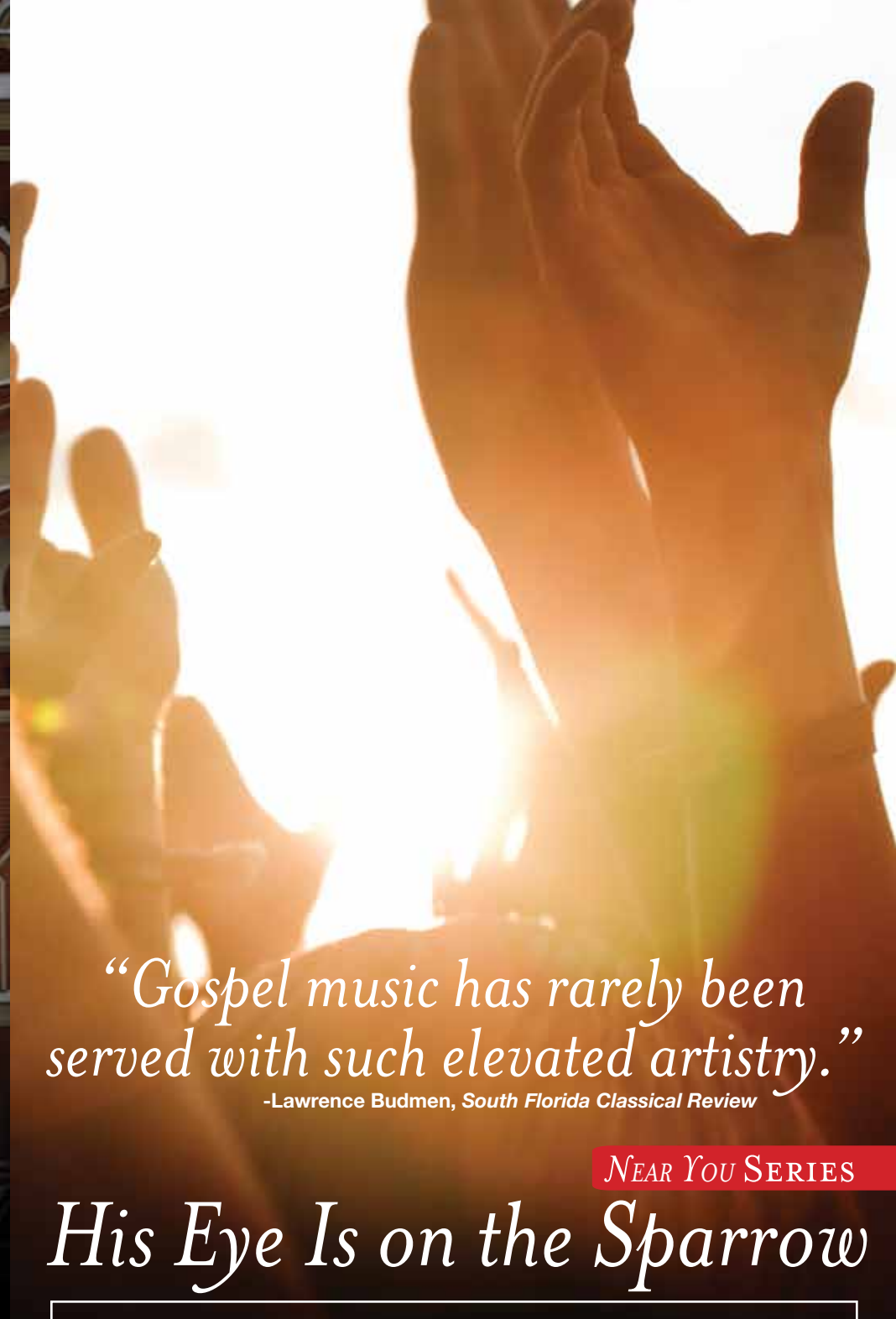

Orff's *Carmina Burana*

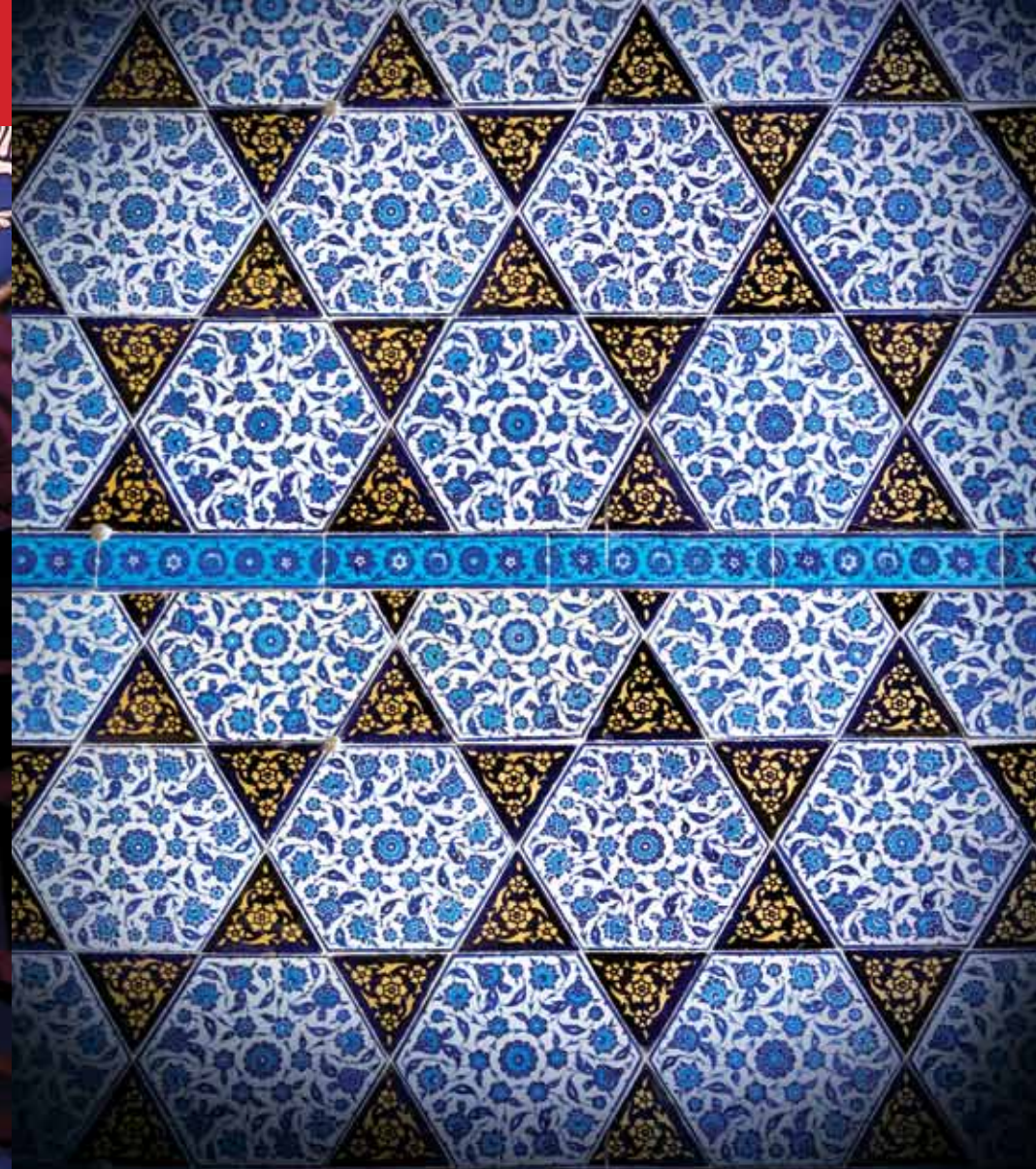

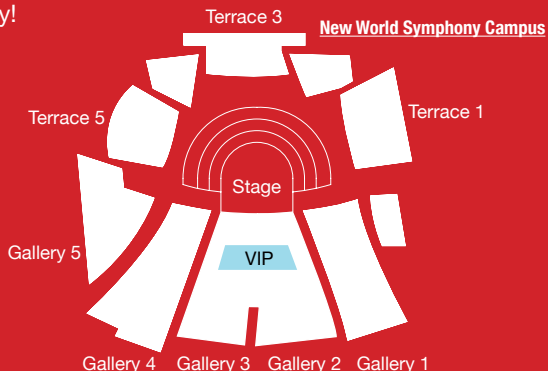
