POSITION SUMMARY

The Concert Production Associate is responsible for advancement operations, load-in, execution, and load-out of concert events for Seraphic Fire, a not-for-profit cultural arts organization based in Miami, Florida, with an annual operating budget of \$2.1 million.

CONCERT PRODUCTION RESPONSIBILITIES

- Execute advancement operations for all concerts and special events. Advancement includes transportation of Seraphic Fire equipment, stage setup and teardown, and other duties as assigned. (vehicle provided for all concert transportation needs)
- Coordinate with venues and vendors to ensure all deliverables are received and executed within the schedule set by the Finance and Operations Manager.
- Maintain and protect Seraphic Fire equipment, instruments, and assets while on-site.

ADDITIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- At concerts, assist with Will Call, Box Office, and Merchandise table as requested.
- Assist with returning rental equipment and instruments at the end of the concert run.
- Assist with the distribution of audience surveys.
